Hello,

I have a pair of extra-height glass doors which open inwards in the living room of my apartment, with a Juliette balcony outside behind them. I would like to find blinds which I can see out of (and which let the sunlight in through), but which people on the other side of the street cannot see in through, to fit over the glass in the door frames. I was thinking Voile white, but open to suggestions too?

I'm thinking the INTO style might work, roller or similar, that I can pull down from the top to perhaps halfway up from floor height. The doors stretch from floor to ceiling. Or I have also heard of PerfectFit blinds?

The actual glass panels on each of the two doors are the following dimensions: H 229cm ; W 53cm ; Inset depth in metal door frame 3cm.

Would you be able to let me know if you can do this sort thing, and what type of material and blind style (roller vs other) you would recommend?

Could you also give me an idea of cost, including survey and fitting?
