But here we go, we have 2 no options of wind resistance.

The price I am quoting, includes installing the post in Steel, powder coated to a color of your choice. Plus all hardware in Stainless Steel, plus a winch for tensioning.

Option 1

, that will withstand 60 mph of wind, in a sun shade fabric Soltis 86, probs the fabric you are familiar with. £ 5152.00

plus GST

Colour Boulder

Option 2

That will withstand 40 mph of wind, fabric as above. £ 4166.00 plus GST

If you would like to see what colours they come in, we have samples I can drop to you.

Hi Adrian

I think the best way to install this is with a dead fixing in the middle of the wall and a small rigging screw at each end to allow for minor adjustment on first installation. Once these two rigging screws have been set they can be locked off and are unlikely to need to be moved again. The sail can then be removed just by loosening a larger rigging screw at the mast or a winch at the mast.

I can offer this at two load ratings.

60mph - 2t webbing - £2063 delivered any colour in Soltis 86 with welded seams

40mph - 0.8t webbing - £1570 delivered any colour in Soltis 86 with welded seams

Lead time on both of these is 4-5 weeks from confirmation of survey dims

Fittings need to be installed prior to survey - all fittings are held in stock.

As a comparison the same sail in the infresco fabric 40mph rating on rigging screws would be £946.05 with a 2 week lead time.

In the high end shade cloth (monotec 370) the cost would be £1300 on rigging screws - all sewn - lead time 4-5 weeks.
