Hi Gerald

Further to my meeting with Jeff and Nick this morning, the following wish list has been constructed, with no particular issues that I can foresee.

The security shutter, although housed in a concealed head behind the stone façade, would deploy externally to the glass with the side guides being incorporated into the window frame as such.

Then the awning as per your last sketches would be concealed above the shutter position.

With the addition of privacy roller blinds to be dropped when dressing/undressing the window displays, these can be installed in a recess box above the head of the window internally. A space of 100 mm x 100 mm is all that is required. These to be electrically operated.

The entrance door would have a metal framed glass canopy set at the same pitch as the awnings. To give a continuous line when the awnings were extended.

The glass canopy potentially to have a frosted reeded glass panels set into the custom metal frame work.

I hope this is clear and of course happy to discuss further if more information is required.

Hi Adrian,

Further to our telephone call yesterday please see an updated section attached where we hope we could recess your awning box as you would prefer to do.

This is subject to being able to fix additional steelwork to the shopfront ring beams as suggested in our design intent to fix the internal security shutter box to and the associated steelwork sub framing for fixing the granite fascia panels/stonework.

We welcome RGA's comments as to what additional steelwork/load can be added to the building or if a separate framed system is required with loads taken to the ground.

A technical design team call would be useful over this area of the design.
