To supply Exworks **6no. Deans Traditional Awnings**. Awning construction as follows:

- Handmade timber enclosure in 1st Grade Harvested Meranti hardwood *, incorporating:
 - Routed drip rails in front lath and lip to prevent ingress of water (Awnings over 5m wide are liable to deflection)
 - Integrated angled top timber to enable rain to run-off and maximise longevity
 - Integrated colour-coded valance rail (where applicable)
 - Unique pitch design for water run-off
 - All timberwork hand painted or stained to specification
- Awning projection - 1500mm
- Custom steel arms fabricated with steel pivot fixings**
- All metalwork powdercoated to RAL colour of your choice, superior to painted finish for;
 - Superior colour retention
 - Resistant to weathering, corrosion & fading
 - Non-hazardous to the environment (no solvents used)
- Stainless steel galvanised storm chains are fitted for additional security.
- Fabric cover in 300g solution dyed acrylic canvas. Colour TBC*
- Fabric valance – None
- Action – Electric RTS operation with remote control (including motion sensors)

To supply Exworks **1no. Deans Bespoke RIB® Canopy**. Canopy construction as follows:

- Bespoke framework in extruded aluminium incorporating:
 - Bespoke Curved Wedge Canopy
 - 25mm x 25mm minimal section size
 - Integrated ingress to attach fabric directly, enhancing strength and tensioning capability *
 - Powdercoated finish to any RAL colour
 - RIB® Aluminium extruded with welded joints & unique fastening channel for high tension covering
- Canopy projection - 1500mm
- Fabric cover in 300g solution dyed polyester canvas. Colour TBC from our range **
- Fabric valance – None
- Trim - Unique 'self-trim' with fabric piping in exact colour match to main cover
- Action - Fixed (Non-retractable)
- Included items:
 - Specification drawings
 - Lath to match Traditional awnings on either side. Making it look like a traditional awning
- Note: The building may need to be altered to match the canopy, and not the other way round

Please note, the price for the Bespoke RIB canopy is indicative, it includes the cost for the curved timber lath, but further design & development is needed to explore if this can be manufactured in-house or needs to be ordered in.

*All timber used by Deans is from managed forests (registered and harvested) and is FSC or PEFC certified. Timber painted in the colour of your choice using environmentally friendly water-based paints.

**Deans carry out all steel fabrication internally with use of no pre-fabricated, moulded parts.

***Fabric manufactured with SNC coating making it extremely resistant to dirt grease and other pollutants.

****Quotation allows for standard electrical connection to an external fused spur situated within 1metre of the awning motor. Cable can be extended on request. Alternate electrical connections (including bringing the cable inside the property) to be arranged by client.
