

Hi Richard,

I understand Adrian called the other day to discuss the options which would work and has sent me some images of the two options.

The first is the roof mounted brackets to increase the height and therefore the pitch of the awning. The second option is the plaza viva which is the option I briefly discussed on the phone with you.

I have attached a link below to the Plaza viva. It basically allows for a more horizontal awning, but does require 2 small posts at the front. The awning still retracts as it would do a normal awning.

Hi Chrissie & Richard,

Following Adrians meeting with Marcello, we are unable to install awnings at the required projection due to the fixing point on the roof being too low. Adrian and Marcello discussed a louvre system outside the kitchen area, approx. 5m x 4m plus two fix screens or retractable roofs over the other windows on the terrace for heat. We can basically install anything that is horizontal, not with an incline at the 4m projection.

What are your thoughts?
