This document describes how **Production Due Date** and **overdue highlighting** will behave based on job status and whether automation workflows are configured.

When Automation Workflows Exist

If automation workflows are configured, the system will continue to calculate and set up the **Production Due Date** using those workflows. No change is required for the existing behavior.

When No Automation Workflows Exist (Manual / Default Mode)

Quoting Statuses

The system will not fetch the **Created Date** as the **Product Due Date by default in the quoting phase**.

During this **phase**, users can manually enter the **Product Due Date** if required.

Ordering Statuses

Once the job moves to an ordering status, the **Production Due Date** will default to the **Order Date**. Users will be allowed to edit or override the date if required.

Even when the job moves to the Ordering phase, **the Product Due Date** at the line-item level will remain empty if no workflow is configured. It can be manually updated if required.

Invoiced / Completed Statuses

Jobs that are invoiced or completed will never be treated as overdue. On the **All Jobs** page, overdue highlighting based on Production Due Date will be ignored for these statuses, and no row or text color changes will be applied.
