Arriving after 4pm

Departing before 10am

Follow the A30 to the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto the A3074 signposted to St. Ives.

Go straight over the next two roundabouts, keeping to the right on the second roundabout into Lelant.

Follow the A3074 through Lelant and Carbis Bay.

Follow the road down into St. Ives, passing the main entrance to Tregenna Castle on the left.

Follow the road down to Harbour Hotel & Spa and bear left at the junction into Albert Terrace.

Continue along this road and follow the signs for the 1000 space car park and the Leisure Centre.

Continue past the Leisure Centre and follow the road alongside St Ives Infants and Junior School until you reach a double mini roundabout with a Co-operative convenience shop on your right. Turn right at the mini roundabout and follow the road down.

Upon reaching the next mini roundabout turn left and continue straight up the steep hill; into Bullens Lane.

At the top turn right into Ventnor Terrace.

At the top of Porthmeor Hill, turn right into Clodgy View and continue past Barnoon car park on your left-hand side.

Immediately in front of you is a narrow steep hill which has a dead end sign on the wall in front of you. Go down this hill about 30 metres and take the turn on your left immediately after the wall into Godrevy Terrace. The Galleries is the last building on the terrace. You will need to lift the barrier to access the garage.

Keys are in the top key safe next to the mail box code A8937.

The key with an 'FF' emblem opens the garage door. Please park in the parking space marked '1'.

There is an internal door from the garage which takes you to the vestibule at the bottom of the stairs and by the lift door.

Please make sure the key is returned to the safe on your departure, not as stated in the welcome folder.

Parking...

There is a new manually operated barrier to go through. This must be lowered each time for entry and exit to eliminate illegal parking. You can then pull straight into the garage underneath. You are provided with a key to the roller-door, which some people may find a little difficult to open, as it can be stiff. Your space is the first space with a number 1 painted on the floor, you can drive straight into this (on your right).

Additional Information during your stay:

The wheelie bins are located at the rear of the garage, through the door and up the stone steps.
